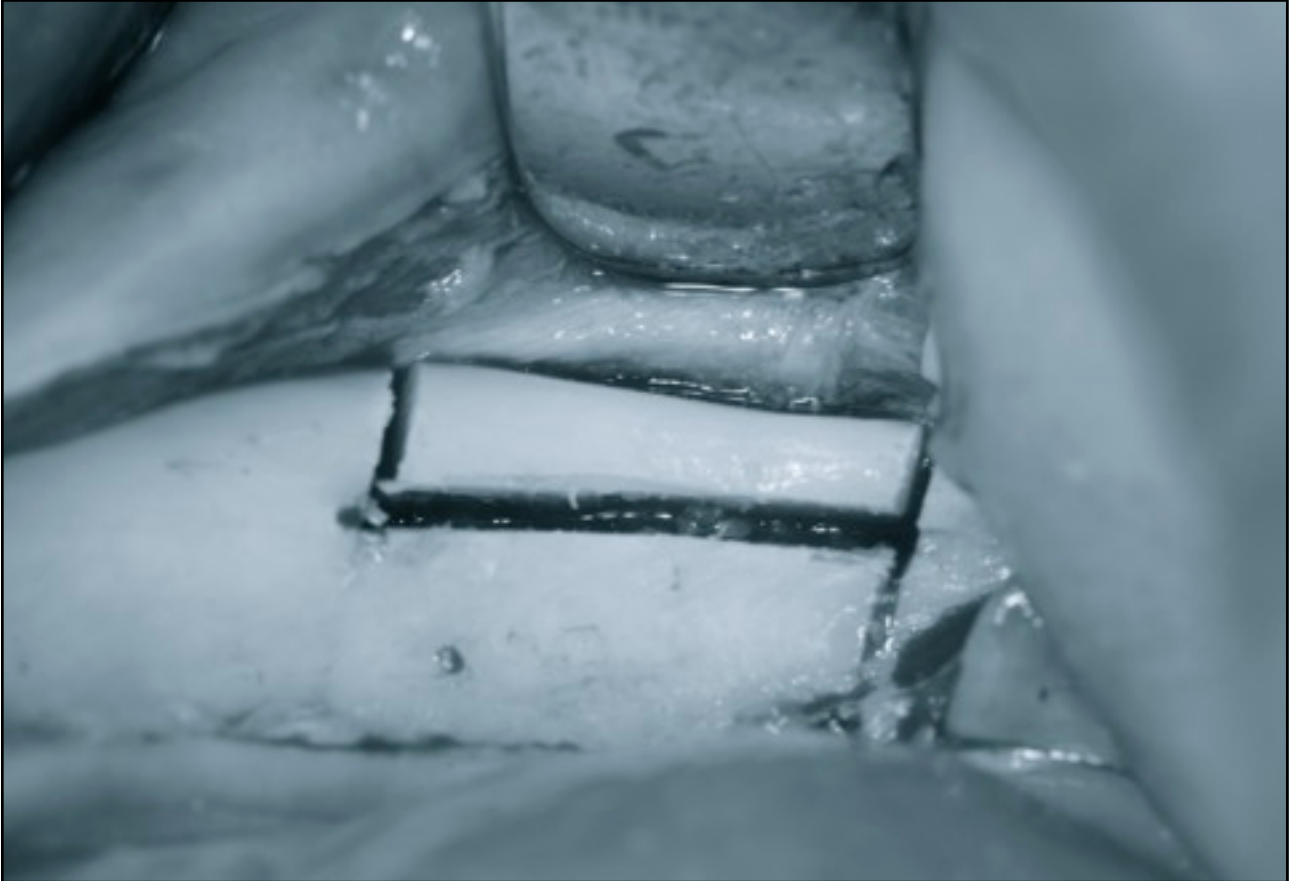

- Trimming and fixing blocks using block fixation pins

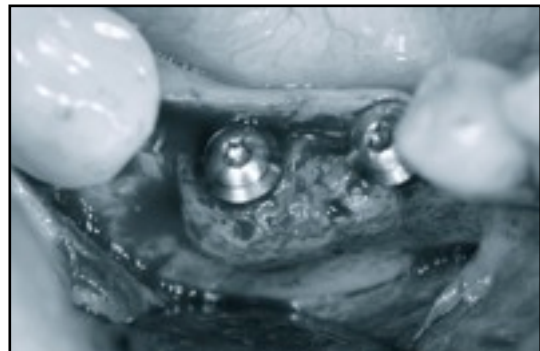
